Design

Digital Printing

We use our production printing equipment to reproduce artwork in either black and white or color. We can make books, booklets, brochures and simple copies. Stapling, cutting, printing carbonless forms, and making pads are all additions that we can do easily. Anything you need for your copying and printing needs is something we can do for you.

Our newest initiative is a web-based order submission system. Final testing is being completed now and the rollout is going to begin with the new year.

Large Format

One of the newest areas of growth for the graphic arts department. We've gone from having a single poster printer capable of printing paper posters, to multiple devices that can print enormous outdoor installations. We've done installations as large as 5' tall x 700' long. You've all seen the work we've done, from Unlimited You banners, to lawn signs, to TUPE posters.

Large format jobs fall into two main categories, rigid material and flexible material. The rigid materials we work with include foam core boards for indoor use and Coroplast boards for outdoor use. Flexible materials include banner vinyl, poster paper, adhesive-backed vinyl, window materials, and a wide variety of other materials.
