The Board of Trustees is the governing body of the district and derives its powers from the Constitution and Statutes of the State of California. The governance of the schools is vested in the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees is the representative of the people of the district. It shall function as a goal setting and policymaking body. The board has complete jurisdiction over the district, its programs, employees, pupils, building sites, and equipment.

Bylaws will be adopted for its own governance which are consistent herewith and within legal limits.
