

Rules (bylaws) necessary for the internal operation of the Board of Trustees shall be formulated by the board. Bylaws may be proposed by members of the board or the superintendent. Proposed bylaws are subject to adoption by a majority vote of all members of the board, with written notification of the proposal being made prior to a regularly scheduled board meeting.

The bylaws of the board shall be subject to amendment or repeal upon a majority vote of all members of the board, with written notification of the proposed amendment or repeal being made prior to a regularly scheduled board meeting.

No bylaw or amendment or revision shall be adopted unless it has been discussed at a meeting prior to adoption.
