Candidate	113-88 Days	Each candidate may prepare a candidate's statement on a form provided by the Registrar of Voters. The statement may contain no more than 200 words unless the governing board of the school district has authorized a 400 word statement. The statement must be filed at the same time that the Declaration of Candidacy is filed. It may be withdrawn, but not changed, during the nomination period and until 5:00 p.m. of the next working day after the close of the nomination period.
