

If a tie vote makes it impossible to determine either which of two or more candidates has been elected to the Board of Trustees, the Board of Trustees may either call a runoff election or determine the winner(s) by lot. Prior to conducting any school board election, the Board of Trustees shall establish which of such procedures is to be employed in the event of a tie vote.
