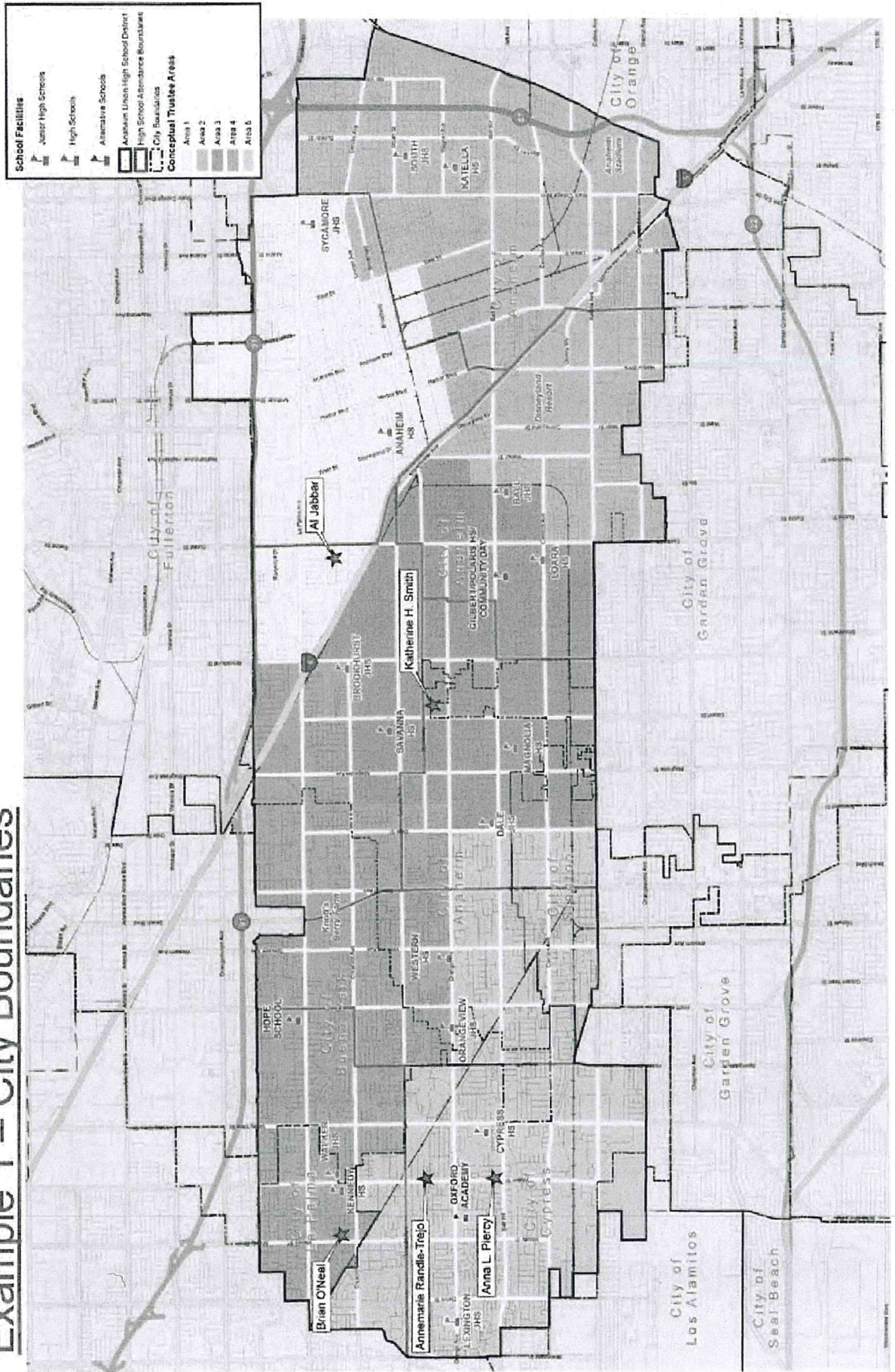

Example 1 – City Boundaries



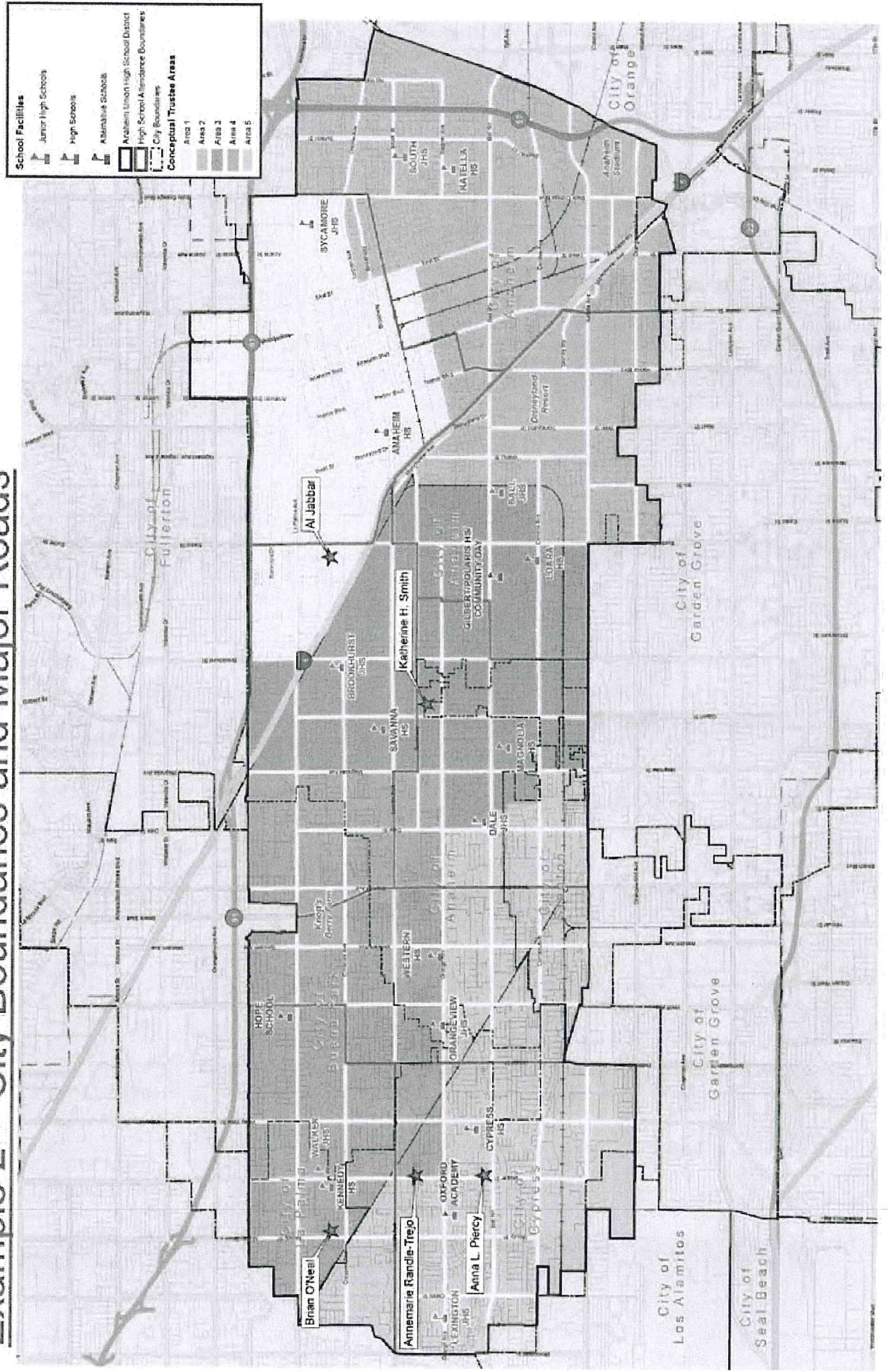
