

The Business Services Division is responsible for establishing and maintaining a district-wide disaster preparedness plan which will include emergency actions to be taken in the event of fire, earthquake, flood, bomb threat, chemical accident, severe windstorm, explosion or threat of explosion, falling aircraft, or war. The plan shall be made available to each certificated employee and classified manager for their information, reference, and use if required.
