

**GRANTING OF ADDITIONAL GRADE POINTS FOR  
SELECTED COURSES**

The intent of this policy is to serve students in grades 10, 11, and 12 who are involved in a more academically rigorous course of study. This provision is in alignment with the philosophy established by the University of California system for entering freshman. Therefore, the Board of Trustees of the Anaheim Union High School district will recognize the effort exerted by the students participating in these selective courses. Due to the extra work involved, the evaluation system used shall be weighted to reflect the more difficult nature of the courses. Any grade in one of these courses will be computed as follows: A=5, B=4, C=3, D=1, F=0. The grades of "D" and "F" are not weighted.
