The Anaheim Union High School District recognizes that homework contributes toward building responsibility, self-discipline and life-long learning habits, and that time spent on homework directly influences students' ability to meet academic standards. The Board expects students, parents/guardians and staff to view homework as a routine and important part of students' daily lives.

Appropriate homework will be assigned by the teacher. Parents/Guardians may anticipate a minimum study and review time of one hour for their student(s) per night. These assignments will be given to assist students to achieve course standards and to give students experience in assuming responsibility for their personal educational development.

Guidelines:

- 1. Required homework and appropriate alternative assignments are the responsibility of each student. Homework will be collected, evaluated, and returned to the student. Students should anticipate a minimum study and review time of one hour per night.
- 2. Quality of required homework rather than quantity will provide teachers with additional measures for evaluation of student's progress.
- 3. Students with valid absences from school will receive credit for completed homework assignments as evaluated by the teacher who assigned the homework. Responsibility for homework and satisfactory completion within time allotted by the teacher are the sole responsibility of the student.
- 4. Parents/guardians shall be notified by staff if students repeatedly fail to complete homework assignments.
