The Board of Trustees directs the superintendent to prepare and review administrative rules and regulations for the granting of waivers from the district graduation requirements consistent with sound educational principles and state minimum guidelines and requirements of the Education Code. Such rules and regulations shall take into account limitations due to physical and mental disability, and special problems beyond the control of the pupil or parents/guardians.

REGULATIONS:

The principal of the school, at least one semester prior to graduation, shall review with his counseling and administrative staff those pupils who are scheduled for graduation. The principal shall order a complete audit of pupils' records that reveal deficiencies.

Upon completion of the audit, the principal shall determine that every reasonable attempt has been made to comply with the district graduation requirements which include:

- 1. Excuse from health instruction on religious beliefs. (Education Code, Section 51240)
- 2. Temporary or permanent exemption from physical education. (Education Code, Section 51241)
- 3. Credit for foreign language private school studies. (Education Code, Section 51243)
- 4. Mentally, physically, and/or educationally disabled. (Administrative Code, Title 5, Section 1601)

To receive an Anaheim Union High School District diploma, the student must meet all Board of Trustees criteria for graduation.

Having satisfactorily completed his/her assessment of individual needs, the principal is authorized to certify for graduation all pupils within his/her school consistent with district policies.
