

Certain days have been set aside for special observances in the public schools. These days are in addition to the commonly observed legal holidays.

Observances with suitable exercises will be on:

- Constitution Day** **September 17**
- Martin Luther King Day** **January 15**  
(Holiday is either Monday or Friday in the week of January 15)  
Observed on the Friday preceding the holiday
- Lincoln's Birthday** **February 12**  
Holiday is February 12  
Observed on the day that school is in session prior to February 12
- Susan B. Anthony Day** **February 15**
- Washington's Birthday** **3<sup>rd</sup> Monday in February**  
(Holiday is the third Monday in February)  
Observed on the Friday preceding the holiday
- Black American Day** **March 5**
- Conservation, Bird and Arbor Day** **March 7**
- California Poppy Day** **April 6**
- John Muir Day** **April 21**
- Day of the Teacher** **Second Wednesday in May**
