However, youth in whom one of a paired organ is missing or essentially nonfunctional should not participate in body contact or collision sports. Examples of paired organ disability include absence or malfunctioning of a kidney, absence of one testis in the scrotum, blindness or severe loss of sight in one eye.

Parents/guardians of students missing a paired organ who want their child to participate in contact sports must sign a release of responsibility releasing the Anaheim Union High School District from any responsibility because of injury sustained while participating in this activity.
