

It is recognized that it may be necessary to reassign administrators because of declining enrollment, budgetary restrictions, or district needs. When such a reassignment becomes necessary, the superintendent will review such reassignment with the individuals involved.

In designating the administrator to be reassigned, the superintendent's cabinet, shall consider the following criteria: demonstrated leadership, performance, previous experience, credentialing, advanced study, participation in special programs, and seniority.

An administrator, who has been reassigned due to declining enrollment, budgetary restrictions, or district needs, shall be given consideration for reappointment to vacancies in administrative positions prior to consideration of other candidates.

Administrators being reassigned must be notified of such reassignment in accordance with Education Code Section 44951.
