

SALARY SCHEDULE ADVANCEMENT, LONGEVITY PAY AND DOCTORAL STIPEND ADMINISTRATORS 6616

- 1.0 An anniversary increment, based on the current management salary schedule, shall be granted to any administrator with 15 complete years of continuous service in the district.
- 2.0 An anniversary increment, based on the current management salary schedule, shall be granted to any administrator with 20 complete years of continuous service in the district.
- 3.0 An anniversary increment, based on the current management salary schedule, shall be granted to any administrator with 25 complete years of continuous service in the district.
- 4.0 An anniversary increment, based on the current management salary schedule, shall be granted to any administrator with 30 complete years of continuous service in the district.
- 5.0 An additional annual stipend, based on the current management salary schedule shall be granted to any administrator with an earned doctoral degree from an accredited university.

All degrees and credits earned must be from accredited colleges and universities.

For purposes of this policy, accredited institutions shall be listed in the American Association Collegiate Registrar Admissions (AACRA), Council on Post Secondary Accreditation (COPA), or Association of American Education.

- 6.0 All qualified administrators shall advance one horizontal step on the salary schedule for each year of service, except those whose placement is at the maximum step.
